Britain in the Americas - The First 200 Years			
1497	John Cabot (Venetian Giovanni Caboto sailing for England) lands in Newfoundland		
1508	Sebastian Cabot sails extensively along coastal North America (?Hudson Strait to Chesapeake Bay?)		
1576-78	Martin Frobisher reaches Baffin Island, Frobisher Bay, Hudson Strait in search of a Northwest Passage		
1583	Sir Humphrey Gilbert founds St. John's fishing settlement in Newfoundland		
1585 & 87	Roanoke Colony twice founded and twice failed		
May 1607	First settlers arrive Jamestown (lasted 92 years) under the Virginia Company of London's royal charter		
Aug 1607	Popham Colony in Maine founded (lasted 14 months) under the Plymouth Company's charter		
1607-11	Henry Hudson sailing for England and then Netherlands explores New York to Hudson Bay, Canada		
1612	St. George's, Bermuda founded under auspices of the Virginia Company, later the Somers Isles Company		
1620	The Mayflower lands; Plymouth Colony founded under a land authorization from the Plymouth Company		
1623	British colonize St. Kitts		
1624	Virginia Company's charter is dissolved - Jamestown becomes a royal colony		
1625-27	7 Barbados claimed for British crown and settled		
1628	Nevis is settled (from St. Kitts). The Plymouth Colony becomes the Massachusetts Bay Colony		
1630	Boston established by John Winthrop fleet with over 700 settlers		
1632	Antigua and Montserrat settled by British from St. Kitts		
1636	Harvard founded. Roger Williams founds Providence.		
1636-8	The Pequot War (native Americans vs. Massachusetts Bay colonists - the latter decisively prevail)		
1650	Anguilla is settled (from St. Kitts). First British settlers (pirates) begin logging settlements in Belize.		
1655	Jamaica occupied by British → formally ceded by Spain in Treaty of Madrid 1670		
1675-78	King Philip's War - last stand of native Americans in southern New England		
1691	The Massachusetts Bay Colony becomes a royal colony		
1699	Jamestown is abandoned after 92 years. Williamsburg becomes the capital of the Virginia Colony		
1700	Barbados is the most populous colony in British America - exceeding Virginia, Massachusetts, Jamaica and New York		

Note: Britain would later definitively acquire (by naval might and diplomacy) the following Caribbean islands: Dominica, St. Lucia, Grenada, St. Vincent & Grenadines, Trinidad & Tobago, the Cayman Islands, and British Virgin Islands.
