South Sea Tales by Jack London, includes several of his most acclaimed South Seas short stories. The original and still-classic version includes 8 stories.

Son of the Sun – A novel weaving together 8 tales of South Sea adventures based on the life of fictional South Pacific adventurer David Grief

The Chinago - short story set in French Polynesia

The Red One - short story set in the Solomon Islands (with a touch of sci-fi)
